Eligibility of Participants:

All entries must meet the following criteria: • Author Status: No restrictions on age, qualification or nationality. Any individual interested can participate. • Co-Authorship: Papers written by more than one individual are permitted. In case of Co-authored or multiple-authored papers, winners will share the specified monetary awards. • Single Submission: Only one paper allowed by an author, whether as sole author or as a co-author • Originality: Each paper must be an original analysis and must be the author's own work. Papers on previously published materials are not eligible. • Data: Each paper must analyze data already available in the said subject as research papers, policy documents or any such with credibility and should duly refer to it in the references • Preparation: Paper adheres to preparation requirements (see below). • Entry Form: Entry form should be duly completed and submitted alongwith submission.

• **Deadline: All papers and corresponding entry forms must be received by midnight Indian Standard Time, January 1st, 2019.**

Paper Preparation Requirements :

The paper must be written in English and follow these requirements:

Reporting Guideline:

Submissions that follow the SRQR Reporting Guideline will be given preference over others but it is not mandatory to adhere strictly to it. More details: <http://avpresearch.org/srqr.pdf>

Length:

Paper should be no longer than 30 pages. Page limits include all charts/graphs, references, and any appendices.

Appearance and Format :

- Font should be Times New Roman - point size 12
- Margins of 1 inch (2.5 cm) all around
- Double spaced
- Papers must be submitted in MS Word (doc or docx).

Title Page and Abstract :

- The title page must include the author's name, institutional affiliation, expected degree (or recently received degree) and graduation date (month/year), and email address.
- An abstract of no more than 250 words must follow the title page. Title and abstract pages are not included in page limits.
- Page headers and/or footers should contain page numbers and a shortened title of the paper. They are not to include the author's name or the name of his or her institution. This ensures anonymous review by the judges.
- All Sanskrit words SHOULD be written in Roman transliteration with the diacritical marks. Devanagari script is only additional and optional.
- All Sanskrit terms (when equivalent English terminologies are not available) should be translated and the original term and the closest translation should be mentioned in brackets.

Charts :

- Charts and graphs should be "stylized"; that is, exhibits should be developed, formatted, and inserted into the document appropriately. Cutting and pasting direct output from statistical software into the document is not satisfactory.

References/Citation :

- References are mandatory
References should be numbered consecutively in the order in which they are first mentioned in the text (not in alphabetic order). Identify references in text, tables, and legends by Arabic numerals with square bracket around, after the punctuation marks. The references has to be written in Vancouver style.

Standard journal article (for more than six authors): List the first six contributors followed by et al.

Submission Method:

1. Papers must be submitted electronically along with the proper Entry/Publication Release Form for the entered competition. They must be sent to the correct email address, as indicated in this section. A complete entry includes the research paper and the appropriate Entry Form and Copyright Form **in the same, single email**.
2. **Note:** *The email must be copied to all co-authors(if any) listed the application form.*
3. Please complete all information and save the files (entry form and the research paper) using the appropriate file-naming format from among the following:

Article file no where should contain the name of author/s except the last name in the file, this is to facilitate unbiased judging.

Confirmation :

After all materials have been received, a confirmation email will be sent to the author(s) listed on the application form.

Judging :

- **Panels:** Papers will be judged by panels of at least three judges designated by the Organisers.
- **Criteria:** Papers will be judged according to scholarly criteria including statement of purpose, quality of analysis, and supporting documentation.
- **Anonymity:** The judges will not know the entrants' name or affiliations.

Awards :

- Awards will be announced on 14th April 2019
- Selected papers will be published in Ancient Science of Life, after thorough further peer review process and all winning papers will be published on the AVP/AVPRF website.
- Each winner will receive a framed certificate in recognition of the award along with the cash prize.
